You [God] created all things, and it is for your pleasure that they exist and were created.

Revelation 4:11 (NLT)

That's what it means to "love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul." God wants you to love him passionately.

WHAT ON EARTH AM I HERE FOR?

The first reason God put you on earth was for you to get to know him and love him back.

He is a God who is passionate about his relationship with you.

Exodus 34:14b (NLT)

"I don't want your sacrifices—I want your love; I don't want your offerings—I want you to know me."

Hosea 6:6 (TLB)

The greatest way to express your love to God is by giving your life to him.

Give yourselves completely to God since you have been given new life.

Romans 6:13b (NLT)

We love Him because He first loved us.

1 John 4:19 (NKJV)

Worship is on God.

That's what it means to "love the Lord your God . . . with all your mind." God wants you to love him thoughtfully. God wants your focus because he is focused on you.

You have looked deep into my heart, LORD, and you know all about me. You know when I am resting or when I am working . . . You notice everything I do and everywhere I go.

Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

Colossians 3:2 (NIV)

Establish a daily time with God.

"Find a quiet, secluded place so you won't be tempted to roleplay before God. Just be there as simply and honestly as you can manage. The focus will shift from you to God, and you will begin to sense his grace."

Matthew 6:6 (MSG)

Develop constant conversation with God.

Worship him continually.

Psalm 105:4b (TEV)

You [Lord] will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, whose thoughts are fixed on you!

Isaiah 26:3 (NLT)

When you fix your thoughts on God, God will fix your thoughts.
